



House Policy (Jammers & Patrons)

- Jammers, please write your name on the whiteboard by 8:00 pm if you want to participate in the jam session.
- Each group of jammers will perform a maximum of three songs, totalling no more than 15 minutes.
- If there are too many jammers, the Jam Coordinator reserves the right to adjust the jams according to the given timeframe.
- The vocalist will choose the songs, key, and tempo.
- Latecomer jammers may not be guaranteed a spot, but the Jam Coordinator will try to provide everyone with a chance to jam.
- Any committee member or the Jam Coordinator reserves the right to refuse participation in any act for individuals who exhibit disruptive behaviour or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Jammers are not allowed on stage during a jam unless the Jam Coordinator invites them.
- Patrons and musicians are expected to respect each other's space and refrain from using foul language. Please note that abusive, disrespectful, or harmful behaviour towards anyone will not be tolerated, and the offender will be asked to leave the club.
- Musicians are asked to respect and take care of HBC equipment.
