

House Policy (Jammers & Patrons)

- Jammers, please write your name on the whiteboard by 8:30 pm if you want to participate in the jam session.
- Each group of jammers will perform a maximum of three songs, with a total duration of no more than 15 minutes.
- If there are too many jammers, the Jam Coordinator reserves the right to adjust the jams according to the given time frame.
- The vocalist will choose the songs, key, and tempo.
- Latecomer's jammers may not be guaranteed a spot, but the Jam Coordinator will try to provide everyone with a chance to jam.
- Any committee member or Jam Coordinator reserves the right to refuse participation to any act or individuals who exhibit disruptive behaviour or are under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Jammers are not allowed on stage during a jam unless the Jam Coordinator invites them.
- Patrons and musicians are expected to be respectful of each other's space and refrain from using foul language. Please note that any abusive, disrespectful, or harmful behaviour towards anyone will not be tolerated, and the offender will be asked to leave the club.
- Musicians are asked to respect and take care of HBC equipment.
